

Normally, my director's notes are introspective and deep. These aren't. That's because sometimes we have to do things for no other reason than that they make us smile. That's exactly what this show does for me.

I'm probably more excited about SpongeBob than any other show I've ever performed in or directed. And that is sayin' something, because I got "bit" by the theatre bug at age 2.5. 


Reese Flescher (Rainbow Neon Tetra/Sardine Devotee)






Karen Trujillo (Lead Scenic Artist)
